Core Options Sheet for students starting in Fall 2021 and Fall 2022

Core Foundations

- CORE 100 (2 or 3 SH) Community and Commitments taken by all students in the first semester (fall)
- Foundations of Christianity I REL 121 or REL 131 (3 or 4 SH) typically taken by students in the second or third semesters of the model program
- Foundations of Christianity II (2 SH minimum) options from ENGL, HIST, PHIL, and REL

Competencies and Skills

- Foundational Writing **ENGL 101** (3 or 4 SH) or ENGL 100/102 (but this would require a course taken in the summer in order to complete the program in 4 years) typically taken by students in the second or third semesters of the model program
- **Health and Movement** (2 SH) one credit of Fitness and Wellness, and one credit of Recreation, Sport, and Skill (one exemption possible for intercollegiate athletics)
- World Languages I the typical expectation is that this will be satisfied by 3 years of language in HS with grades of B or better (the model program does not include space for language courses to fill WL I)
 - For the incoming classes up to fall 2023, 2 years of language with C or better is being accepted for this requirement

Knowledge and Understanding: 8 courses from at least 5 categories (superscripts denote categories 1-6)

- 1. Natural Sciences¹ CHEM 101 or 103 and lab (required in program)
- 2. Natural Sciences¹ PHYS 133 and lab (required in program)
- 3. Mathematical Sciences² MATH 171 (required in program)
- 4. Arts and Rhetoric³ IDIS 102 (2 SH) or COMM 100 (4 SH) (required in program)
- 5. Social and Behavioral Sciences⁴ ECON 151/191/221/222/232/233 (required in program)
- 6. One course must be from the Humanities⁵ or World Languages II⁶ categories
- 7. 8. Two courses can be from Humanities⁵, Arts and Rhetoric³, World Languages II⁶, or Social and Behavioral Sciences⁴
 - Unless a student plans to satisfy the three core tags in some other way, each of the above three courses MUST BE TAGGED.
 - Note that courses within a category must be taken from different disciplines (e.g. IDIS 102 is part of the "Oral and Visual Rhetoric" discipline and a second Arts and Rhetoric course would need to be taken from one of the other disciplines). See the <u>University Catalog</u> for details.
