Mineral Spotlight: Specular Hematite

Your car, refrigerator, silverware, and every iron-bearing product you own possibly came from hematite—the most significant iron ore on Earth. Hematite has several varieties, including specular hematite, which forms as masses of tiny scale-like crystals that shimmer when illuminated.

Key Facts:

- "Specular" alludes to the mirror-like property of this hematite variety
- The Lake Superior region is the world's largest producer of hematite
- Mars owes its nickname, "the Red Planet," to its abundance of hematite, which appears red in powdered form.
