

**Student screens positive for a concerning symptom on #CampusClear or develops concerning symptoms while on campus AND has no known exposure to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days**

**COVID Case Manager evaluation is required**

**Clear alternative diagnosis**  
(e.g. ear infection, IBS, Crohn's, arthritis)

Can return to campus after 24 hours of resolution of fever and improvement in symptoms with note from case manager

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

**No Clear alternative diagnosis**

**COVID-19 testing indicated**

Student stays home/dorm until results are back

Healthy household members should stay home until results are back

**Negative Molecular/PCR Test:** Stay home/in dorm until fever free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medicines, and symptoms improving

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

**Positive Test:** Isolate for at least 10 days, until fever free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medicines, and symptoms improving. A negative test is NOT needed to return to school.

Household members must quarantine at home the entire time the positive student is in isolation AND for 14 days after last exposure to student with COVID-19 or until cleared by the health department

**Testing not done:** Assume the student is positive and isolate for at least 10 days, symptoms improving and fever free for 24 hours

Household members must quarantine at home the entire time the positive student is in isolation AND for 14 days from last exposure to student with COVID-19 or until cleared by the health department

**Symptoms concerning for COVID-19 in adults**  
Any **two** of the following:

- chills
- body aches
- headache
- sore throat
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- fatigue
- congestion or runny nose

**OR**

**One** of the following:

- fever (measured or subjective)
- cough
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell



## Student has symptoms that are NOT as concerning for COVID-19 or has only one of the symptoms on the list AND has no known exposure to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days:

Has the student been around anyone who has been sick in the past 14 days?

**YES -> COVID-19 testing recommended**

**NO -> COVID-19 Testing Not necessary but recommended**

If testing is done, student stays home until results are back. Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

### Negative Test:

Stay home until fever free for 24 hours and student improving

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

### Positive PCR Test: Isolate

for at least 10 days. A negative test is NOT needed to return to school

Household members must quarantine at home the entire time the positive student is in isolation AND for 14 days after last exposure to student with COVID-19 or until cleared by the health department

### If testing is not done:

Stay home until fever free for 24 hours and symptoms are improving.

\*If symptoms do not improve in 2 days, contact a healthcare provider and have testing for COVID-19

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

### Symptoms concerning for COVID-19 in adults

Any **two** of the following:

- chills
- body aches
- headache
- sore throat
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- fatigue
- congestion or runny nose

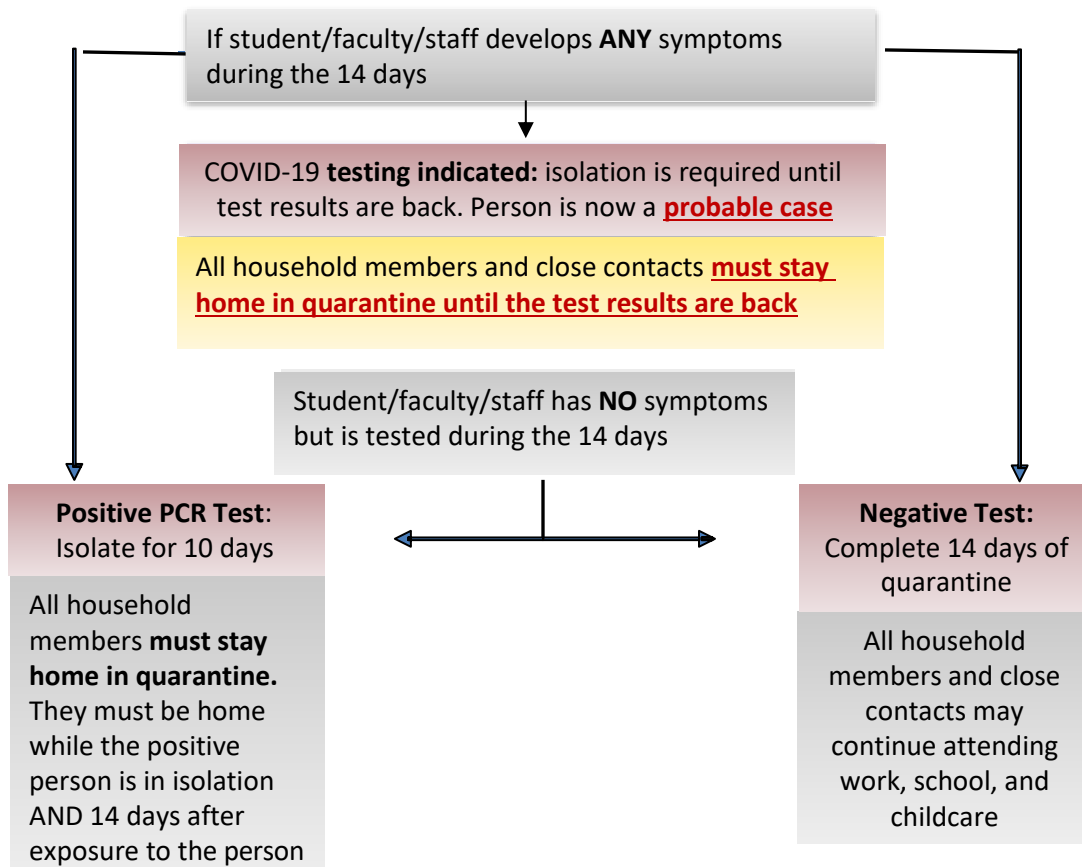
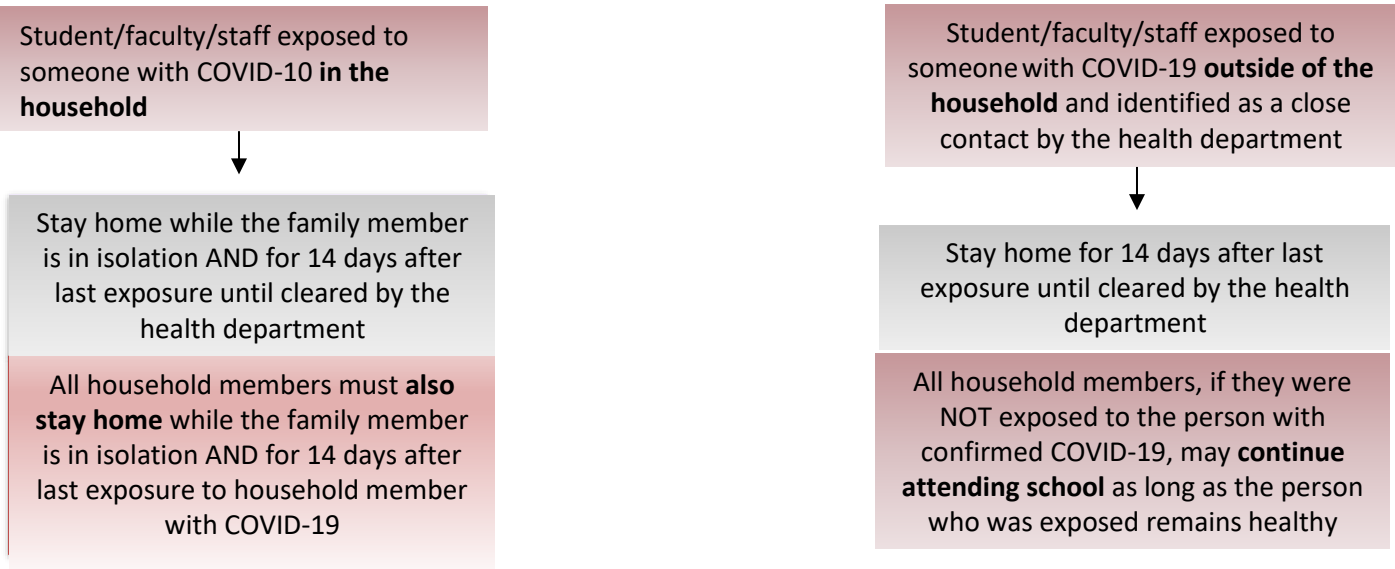
OR

**One** of the following:

- fever (measured or subjective)
- cough
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell

Symptom Algorithm for Calvin University (adapted from KCHD)

- Stay home for 14 days after last exposure until cleared by the health department
- Consider COVID-19 testing. Must complete 14 days of quarantine EVEN if test is negative



Symptom Algorithm for Calvin University (adapted from KCHD)

**A negative COVID-19 test does not mean a student can end the 14-day quarantine before 14 days**

Faculty/Staff screens positive for a **symptom** on #CampusClear AND has **no known exposure** to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days:

If you have at least **two** of the following symptoms:

- chills
- body aches
- headache
- sore throat
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- fatigue
- congestion or runny nose

OR

Any **one** of the following symptoms:

- fever (measured or subjective)
- cough
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell



HR case manager evaluation is required

**Clear alternative diagnosis**  
(e.g. Crohn's, IBS, arthritis)

Can return to campus after 24 hours resolution of fever and improvement in symptoms or note from healthcare provider

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

**No clear alternative diagnosis**

COVID-19 testing indicated – Stay home until results are back

**Negative Test:** Stay home until fever free for 24 hours without using fever reducing medicines and symptoms improve

Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare

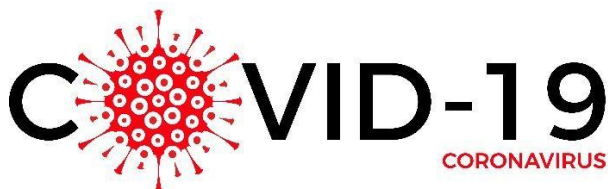
**Positive PCR Test:** Isolate for at least 10 days. A negative test is NOT needed to return to school

Household members must **quarantine** at home the entire time the positive staff is isolated AND for 14 days after last exposure to staff with COVID-19, or until cleared by the health department

**Testing not done:** Assume the staff is positive and isolate for at least 10 days

Household members must **quarantine** at home the entire time the staff is isolated AND for 14 days after last exposure to the staff or until cleared by the health department

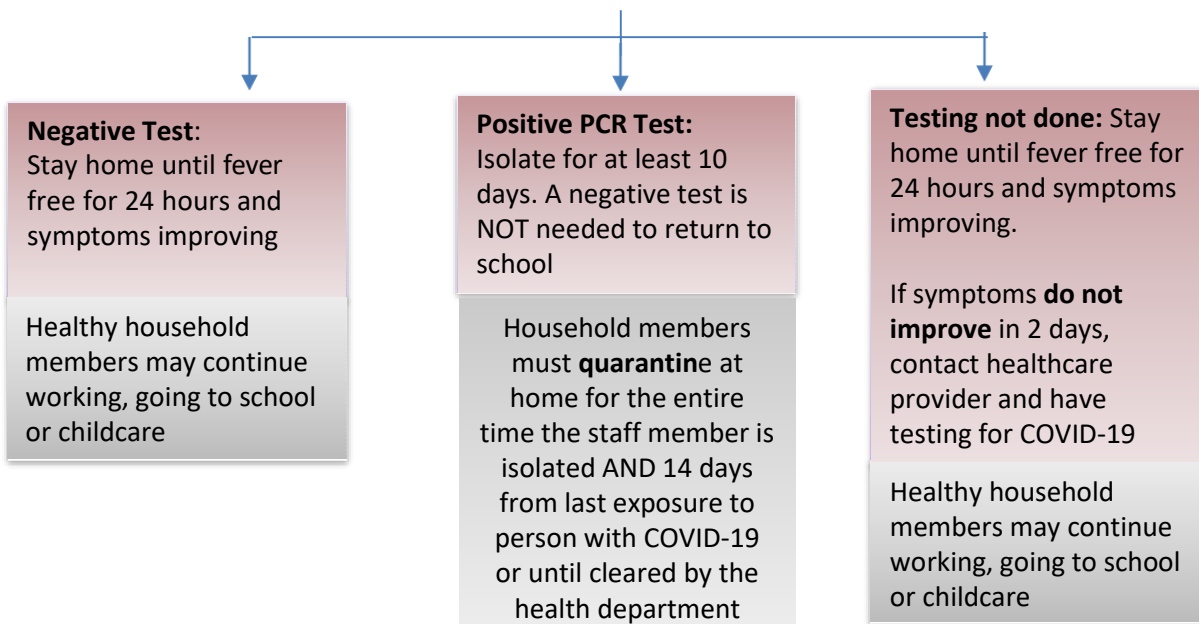
Symptom Algorithm for Calvin University (adapted from KCHD)



Your symptoms do not meet the criteria below.

Have you been around anyone who has been sick in the past 14 days?

<b>YES</b> -> COVID-19 testing recommended	<b>NO</b> -> Testing not necessary but recommended
If testing is done, staff stays home until results are back. Healthy household members may continue working, going to school or childcare	



Seasonal or environmental allergies look like COVID. If you are not sure, get a COVID test and stay home until the results are back. If your screening happened during allergies, still answer #CampusClear honestly and work with case manager for alternative reporting options.

Symptom Algorithm for Calvin University (adapted from KCHD)

**Symptoms concerning for COVID-19 in adults**  
Any **two** of the following:

- chills
- body aches
- headache
- sore throat
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- fatigue
- congestion or runny nose

If you **do not** meet these criteria, then follow the guidance above

**OR**

**One** of the following:

- fever (measured or subjective)
- cough
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell
