



CLASS OF 2012 GRADUATE REPORT

Calvin College Career Development

Data collected for a 12 month period beginning February 2012 and ending February 2013.

Methodology

This report includes Calvin College graduates from December 2011 through August 2012. The statistics in this report are based on survey information received through multiple sources. Students were offered an incentive gift card of \$15 to the campus store for the following reporting methods.

- February 2012: Senior graduation planning event survey
- Spring 2012 - Fall 2012: Online report form
- May 2012: Alumni survey as students picked up their graduation gown

Department chairs and faculty were asked to assist in gathering information related to graduates who had not reported their activity. In June 2012 through February 2013, the Career Development Office followed up with graduates using Calvin's on-line alumni network, LinkedIn, Facebook and e-mail.

Internship information was obtained from the graduate surveys and Career Development's college wide internship database.

Highlights

- 86.8% reported their post-graduate activity
- 82% reported having at least one internship/practicum while at Calvin
- 69.7% are professionally employed while 26.2% are in graduate school
- 4.0% are employed but seeking better employment and .1% are not employed
- 53.3% reported residing in Michigan
- 90.5% reported residing in the United States

664 out of the total 810 grads (82%) had at least one internship/practicum while at Calvin. This includes required practicums (e.g. student teaching) as well as optional experiences.
