



ROTC AT CALVIN

SERVE YOUR COUNTRY. STUDY AT CALVIN. AT THE SAME TIME.

Calvin College is an affiliate school of Western Michigan University's Army ROTC Program.

This means that you can take your full time class load at Calvin and also participate with the WMU ROTC program.

HOW IT WORKS

Apply to WMU as a non-degree seeking student. wmich.edu/apply/undergraduate
And apply to Calvin. calvin.edu/apply

Next, simply enroll in WMU's Military Science and Leadership classes and in Calvin's classes. Then begin doing ROTC along with your class load at Calvin.

COSTS

Army ROTC scholarship recipients have tuition covered at both universities. Those not on ROTC scholarships need to pay tuition and fees at both institutions.

CREDIT

Calvin College has agreed to grant Physical Education credit for those who become Cadets with the program and participate in the Physical Training (PT) program. PT is conducted M/W/F mornings from 6 a.m. to 7 a.m. on Calvin's campus.

LOCATION

All classes and most labs are conducted one block from Calvin's campus.

TIME REQUIREMENTS

This will vary depending on your class level:

- **Freshmen** have a one-hour class and a two-hour leadership lab per week
- **Sophomores** have a two-hour class and two-hour leadership lab per week
- **Juniors** have a three-hour class and a two-hour leadership lab per week
- **Seniors** have a three-hour class and a two-hour leadership lab per week

All grade levels participate in physical training.
