

Campus Safety Department Public Safety Advisory:

UPDATE: Larceny from Motor Vehicles, Knollcrest East, Apartments October 8, 2018

Incident Information:

Since Wednesday, September 5, 2018, the Campus Safety Department has taken eight reports of larcenies or attempted larcenies from motor vehicles parked in the lower Knollcrest East parking lots (Lot 18 & 19). In each instance, students advised someone had entered their unlocked vehicles and either stole personal property or searched through glove compartments and center consoles. The most recent incidents occurred at approximately 4:00 a.m. on October 7, 2018 in Knollcrest East parking lot #19.

Suspect Information:

There were two unknown male suspects involved in the latest incidents on October 7. Suspect #1 is on video surveillance wearing a green hooded sweatshirt with an emblem on the chest, jeans and black shoes. Suspect #2 is seen wearing a blue hooded sweatshirt, jeans and white shoes.

Recommendation:

Everyone is strongly encouraged to <u>remove any valuables</u> (i.e. purses, wallets, phones and computers) that are in your vehicle. If you choose to leave valuables in your vehicle, lock them in the trunk so they are not in plain sight. <u>Lock the vehicle's doors.</u> Report any suspicious activity or persons that you observe wandering in parking lots and checking vehicles.
