<b>Notes:</b>	A Calvin employee reported incidents of stalking on behalf of another employee of the University. The employee who was the victim of the reported stalking advised a student kept making unsolicited contact with them, both on Calvin's campus and online. The student was seeking to start a relationship with the employee. Despite repeated declinations of interest by the employee, the student continued to approach them with the intent of establishing a relationship. These incidents of stalking were reported to the Safer Spaces coordinator for follow up investigation.
