
The configuration of automatic content imports must be done through the back-end tool named: Content Import Jobs.

To have access to the "Content Import Jobs" tool, users need to have assigned the role: "Content Importer"



Task Name and Task Description parameters are informative.

The Execute parameters allow to:

- Configure a start and end date for the execution of the import. Every time the task is edited, the end date will be set to the current date. If the task is supposed to run without and end date, the end date checkbox must be unselected before saving the changes.
- Configure either a specific hour when the import must be executed or a range of hours when the import will be repeated according to the recurrence set. For example: every day at 3 pm or every day each 15 minutes from 9am to 9pm.
- Configure the import to be executed on specific days of the week, month, or year.

The structure to import allows selecting what type of content will be imported.

The key fields are set when the import must update the content existing on the system. If no key fields are selected, all the rows read from the csv file will be created as new pieces of content.

The file path indicates either a specific file to be imported or the folder from where every .csv file will be imported. If a folder, the csv files will be processed from oldest to newest.

If a report email is entered, an email will be sent to this address indicating the status of the import.

The field separator and text field delimiter characters can be overridden.

If publish content is checked, the new and updated content will be published automatically. Otherwise, the new versions will have to be published manually from the content manager.
